## 2010-2011 Energy Incentive

September 1st, 2010 through April 30th, 2011

#### The 2009-2010 CCPS Energy initiative was a success!

As a school system we reduced the equivalent to 2,351 tons of the greenhouse gas carbon dioxide  $(CO_2)$ , or 11.1 railroad cars full of coal.



### <u>Incentive Details</u>

Earn \$1,000 when your school reduces 11% of your school's baseline energy usage.\*\*

1st place wins \$1,500 2nd place wins \$1,000 3rd place wins \$500

# Each school's usage from Sept 1, 2010—April 30, 2011 will be compared against it's KWH usage between Sept 1, 2007- April 30, 2008.

- The goal for each school is to reduce baseline energy consumption by 11%.
- Each school will earn a prorated amount for savings between 1% and 11%.
- The three top performing schools with the greatest energy reduction relative to their baseline, will be eligible for a bonus cash award of up to \$1,500.
- \*\* Adjusted incentive award amounts are applied to the Brooks Administration Building, Hunting Creek Annex, and Kings Landing Park. Additionally, these facilities are not eligible for the bonus. Since Calvert Middle School is new and has no electricity consumption baseline, they will not be participating the incentive program until next year.
