# 2011-2012 Energy Incentive

## The 2010-2011 CCPS Energy initiative was a success!

Compared to the usage in 2007-2008, as a school system we reduced the equivalent to 597 tons of the greenhouse gas carbon dioxide  $(CO_2)$ , or 3.3 railroad cars full of coal.



# Incentive Quick facts:

Reduce energy consumption from 2007-2008 by more than 11% and your school will earn an award. \*

### Additional Bonus \*\*

1st place wins \$1,500 2nd place wins \$1,000 3rd place wins \$500

## Incentive Details

- Each school's usage from Sept 1, 2011—April 30, 2012 will be compared against it's KWH usage between Sept 1, 2007- April 30, 2008.
- Each school will earn a prorated amount for savings below 11% of the 2007-2008 KWH consumption. \*Awards range from \$1 for an 11.01% reduction to \$1000 for a 21.00% reduction.
- The three top performing schools with the greatest energy reduction will be eligible for a bonus cash award of up to \$1,500.
- \*\* Adjusted incentive award amounts are applied to the Brooks Administration Building, Hunting Creek Annex, and Kings Landing Park. Additionally, these facilities are not eligible for the bonus.
